

Entry Guidelines

- All entries must be confirmed by May 14, 2010.
- Entry fee is \$45.00 payable to Hants County Arts Council. Payment is to accompany the entry form.
- Exhibiting artists must be members of the Hants County Arts Council. Memberships may be purchased at the time of entry at a cost of \$15 which is an annual fee renewable every March 31
- Artists' work may be displayed for sale or not for sale
- A commission of 25% will be taken from the retail sale price of works for sale. The commission is payable to HCAC.
- Artists are permitted up to 5 pieces, space permitting.
- Works accepted for the show can be in the following categories: Painting, Drawing, Photography, Pottery, Sculpture, Textile, Wood, Glass, and/or Stone. If you have something else in mind, please contact us. **All art work must be originals, no reproductions.**
- All works must be presentable, mounted, ready to hang and preferably framed.
- Biographies provided by the artist will be on display during the show. Each artist should provide a biography printed on one side of an 8 ½ x 11 sheet no later than May 14, 2010.
- Work is to be dropped off for the show Wed. May 26, between 7–9pm or Thurs. May 27 from 2–6pm. Please call if another time is necessary for you.

- Insurance: We do **not** carry insurance to cover the value of your work. If this is a concern to you, contact your insurance agent. We will, however, take every precaution to care for your work.
- Work has to be removed following the show on Sunday May 30 after 3pm and no later than 5pm. Artists will be paid for their sales by cheque no later than June. 30, 2010.
